



SCENIC FRUIT COMPANY GRADER/SWD TESTER

Job Summary

The Seasonal Grader/SWD Tester will sort, monitor and visually inspect the quality of fruit by applying ODA grading methods. It is the responsibility of the Grader to document variances or anomalies in all samplings in the fruit. In addition, the Seasonal Grader will test fruit for SWD infestation by collecting samples of fruit, placing fruit in a salt solution and watching the fruit closely to observe larvae exiting the fruit. Quantitative samples will be taken; counting quickly while the larvae are still alive and moving is imperative.

Because Food Safety and Quality is a policy enforcement department, employees' behaviors should always exemplify "best practices."

Minimum Requirements

Individual should have the ability to learn and understand ODA instructions and Food Safety. Basic math skills are essential. Reading, writing, and speaking in English is required. Team meetings and cooperation with other departments is essential to success.

Physical Requirements:

While performing the essential functions of this job the employee is frequently required to talk, hear, sit, stand, walk, bend, stoop, kneel; and is occasionally required to climb, balance, crouch and crawl; is frequently required to push, pull, lift and carry up to 40 pounds with assistance; is occasionally required to maintain body balance while ascending or descending ladders or open stairs, and to maintain body equilibrium while bending at the waist or at the knees.

The employee is routinely required to reach with hands and arms; work with the hand or hands in handling, seizing, holding, or grasping motions and with the fingers in fingering, picking and pinching actions to operate objects, tools or controls. Employee will be subject to repetitive motion of arms, wrists, hands, and fingers. Specific vision abilities required include close vision, distance vision, color

vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Work Environment

Work environment may be subject to climate conditions. Environment may be wet and can consist of temperature extremes and excessive noise levels. Employees will be required to adhere to general safety and food safety protocols which may include; wearing smocks, hairnets, beard nets if applicable and will be required to consistently practice the washing of hands. This position consistently works with and around moving parts. Attention to surroundings is crucial as it is a very busy production/manufacturing environment with a lot of forklift traffic in the production line room. Safety training is provided.
